  - a. School updates
    - i. Started the year off pretty well-99% of school is running smoothly- 5 new staff members (Some are not new to school but in a different role this year, some new to school but none are brand new teachers overall)
    - ii. Interventions to fully get going Monday, Aug 26<sup>th</sup> and we are excited to get in the groove.
    - iii. Dismissal going well; drop off in the morning is a little slow and there are some concerns but with anything it takes time to get the flow
    - iv. 75% -80% of parents came to Meet the Teacher
    - v. Watching enrollment and starting to track- more info to come at the next meeting
    - vi. Last year we started working on our A+ application- its due next week- we are almost ready to turn in just working through the last questions with feedback from staff
