Climate and culture – our school mission isn't widely known with our students, which is a goal we've created. Staff – respect has dropped in terms of if staff respects each other. Action steps are to figure out why and how to build respect amongst staff. Promote family engagement – measured by family survey of 90% or higher. Next step would be to continue community engagement events for each quarter. Possibly get desert view employees engagement in tour de sunny slope. Promote PTO to help get them become more self-sustaining (possibly to help them create a consistent schedule). Possibly create an event where PTO can hold an event where kids can come and bring their parents who are not a part of PTO yet. Possibly creating a room that we can rent out to the community for more people involved in the community.
