



##### **Call to order**

##### **2. Minutes**

We discussed and approved the minutes from our last meeting.

##### **3. Public Participation**

- Arizona Opera will be coming to perform at Tumbleweed for our 4-6 Grade students. Parents will be invited to attend.
- Field Day will be held in April under the direction of Mr. Camilli. Families will be invited to attend.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade students will be presenting a music concert under the direction of Mr. Pickens April 20<sup>th</sup>.

##### **4. Old Business**

- Next year's staffing contracts have been provided. They need to be signed and returned by March 23. Many are waiting for the updated pay scale for next year before signing. The pay scale should be addressed at the next Board Meeting.
- Read to Succeed in February was a big hit. Students were able to choose cotton candy as their reward for meeting their reading goals. Reading Coupons are also great incentives that the students enjoy. The coupons allow them extra opportunities on

The PBIS plan includes, but is not limited to, Tiger Tickets, Prizes, ability to nominate teacher/staff for outstanding work, etc. Staff is encouraged to focus on Family and Community Engagement.
- We need to purchase an additional Electronic Stop Sign for the crossing guards. The reason being that if one sign isn't working, there is an extra one on campus for use while repairs are being made. It was voted on and approved to use up to \$750 to purchase another Stop Sign.

#### **6. ASA**

Parents/Guardians are invited to join ASA on Thursday March 9. Parents/Guardians will enjoy meeting their child's teacher and participating in activities.

#### **7. PTO**

- PTO reports that the Peter Piper Pizza event was successful. Eighty students with their families showed up and had a great time.
- PTO is still working on fundraising for some basketball courts on the playground. The plan is to have 'Basketball Shooting Courts' on the Primary Playground, and 'Half Courts' for the intermediate playground.
- PTO is looking for parents who want to be a part of PTO leadership, and ways to encourage parent membership and involvement.
