Number of Parent Respondents (N) = 2935

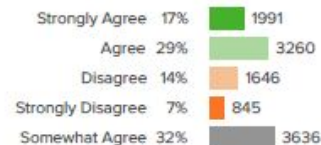

**Q.1: How often do people treat each other with respect at your school?**



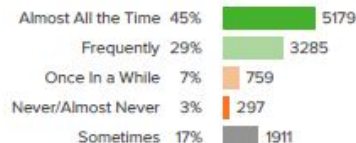

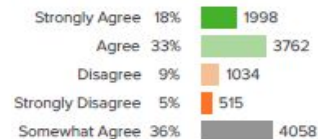

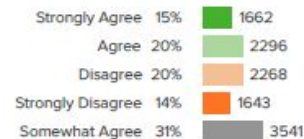

**Q.1: Students in my school can disagree with each other without using physical contact.**



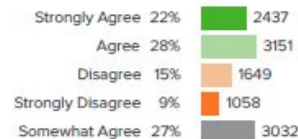

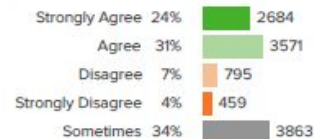

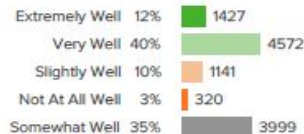

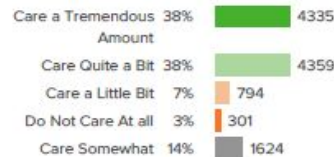

**Q.1: How well do you understand other people's thoughts and ideas?**



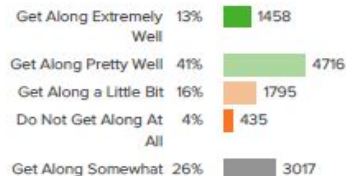

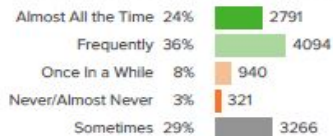

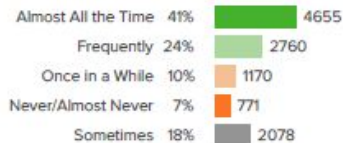

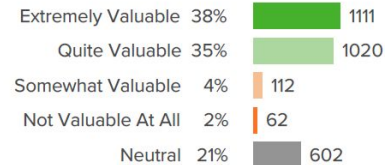

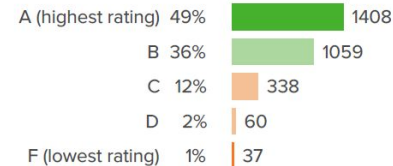
How did people respond?

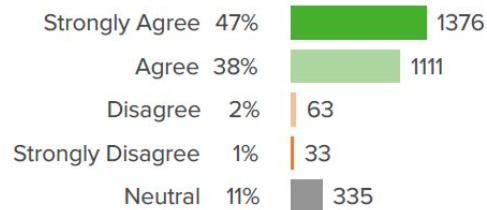

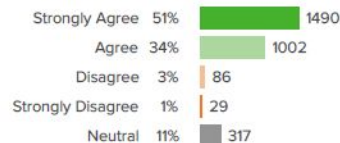

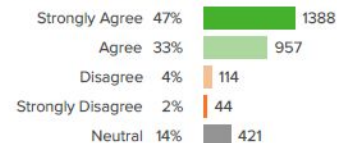

**Q.1: My child knows there is an adult at school whom they can go to for help with an academic problem.**



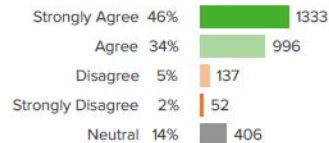

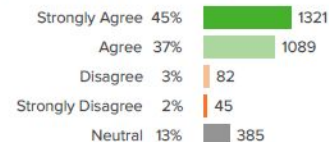

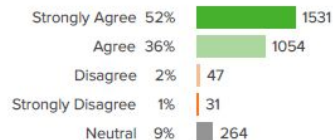

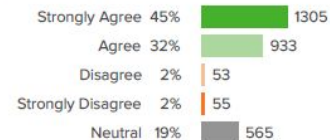

**Q.1: The school staff are available to talk to me.**



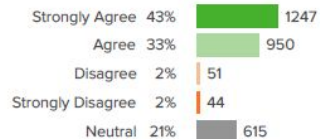

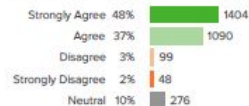

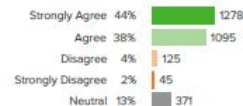

Q.1: My child feels comfortable on campus.



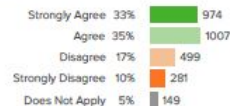

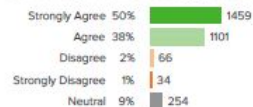
